
- ► Data definitions in the desktop version of Morningstar Direct<sup>SM</sup>

► the **Help/Definitions** page of the Home module, or



How do I find data point definitions in the desktop version of Morningstar Direct?






► the grid view in the Local Databases, Global Databases, Workspace, or Performance Reporting modules, by **right-clicking** on a **column's header**.




To find data point definitions in the next generation of Morningstar Direct, simply **right-click** on a column's header in the Grid View, and select **Show Definition**.

How do I find data point definitions in the next generation of Morningstar Direct?




Morningstar Methodology documents are always found in the next generation of Morningstar Direct. To access these, do the following:
